PUMPKIN PATCH

Thank you for choosing Spina Farms Pumpkin Patch for your school or club field trip this year! We are eager to welcome you and share our rich farming history with you and your group. Please see below for more details.

What to expect:

- Upon arrival, please **check in** at the Information window. A Spina Farms guide will greet you, make adjustments to your invoice if needed, collect any balance due, and direct you to the area where you will begin your tour.
- You'll receive a **guided tour** of the patch which includes a brief interactive demonstration that illustrates the amazing metamorphosis which takes place as a seed transforms into a plant!
- Climb aboard the **Spina Express Train**. Our colorful, nostalgic train is always a favorite of guests of all ages!
- Take a relaxing **hayride** through the corn, sunflower, and zinnia fields. Enjoy the many scarecrows and characters you will see along the way!
- **Reserved Tent** - Privacy and shade for your class. Perfect for taking a break or to eat lunch.

A **Sugar Pie Pumpkin** - each student will receive a Sugar Pie to take home.

- On your way out, **pick a class pumpkin!** Grab a medium size pumpkin for your group to remember the experience all season long!

Pricing:

Students - \$15 each

Teachers - Free. (Max 2 per classroom. Additional teachers or aids will be charged as chaperones at \$8 a person)

Parents/Chaperones - \$10 each (We allow a maximum ratio of 1 chaperone to 8 students. We cannot exceed a 8:1 ratio except for special circumstances. Please reach out with questions)

Acceptable Payment Options: Cash, Check, or Credit Card

*Please note, we will only accept one transaction per group so please collect funds prior to arrival.

*No refunds unless park closures occur due to inclement weather.

Recommendations:

We suggest that your group bring the following items to ensure their comfort:

- Permanent felt tip pen to mark each pumpkin with the children's names.
- School, troop, or club shirts are recommended to easily identify students of each group.
- Sunscreen and a hat - (October can be hot!).
- Sturdy closed-toe shoes are recommended
- Spending money - if they want to purchase additional items from the Snack Shack or Boutique.
- Boxes or bags for transporting your pumpkins home.

Other things to note:

- We recommend arriving 30 minutes before your trip starts to ensure plenty of time to round everyone up and check-in.
- If you arrive late, please note we may have to cut out a scheduled activity to make up for the time lost.
- **PARKING** - Buses can pull up to the no parking zone to drop off and then park in the large parking area while the field trip is taking place. Parking is free for all field trip participants.
- **NO** petting zoo or pony rides Monday - Friday - (Animals are only on-site Saturdays and Sundays from 10am-4pm. Tickets are sold separately from Spina Farms Rides)
- Pumpkin Patch closure may occur with stormy/wet weather conditions due to flooding & safety issues. If that occurs refund or rescheduling is available as dates and time permits.
